Dear Friends in Christ.

Praise the Name of Jesus Who has come to fill us with Himself.

There is something wonderful happening in the believers today that are the direct result of God indwelling His people. This indwelling is producing enthusiasm or God Within.

Enthusiasm: from Greek enthousiasmos, from enthous 'possessed by God, inspired' (based on theos 'God').religious fervor supposedly resulting directly from divine inspiration, typically involving speaking in tongues and wild, uncoordinated movements of the body.

As God fills His people with Himself there is a new enthusiasm, a new freshness, a new revelation of purpose, and a new energy.

People everywhere are excited to tell what is happening in their lives as God fill them with more of Himself.

When Jesus walked on the earth He was filled with the fullness of God.

Colossians 2:9. For in Him the whole fullness of Deity (the Godhead) continues to dwell in bodily form [giving complete expression of the divine nature].

God is also filling us with the complete expression of the divine nature.

Colossians 2:10. And you are in Him, made full and having come to fullness of life [in Christ you too are filled with the Godhead--Father, Son and Holy Spirit--and reach full spiritual stature]. And He is the Head of all rule and authority [of every angelic principality and power].

The Father gave His Spirit to Jesus without measure.

John 3:34 "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure."

Ephesians 3:14-19 For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height--to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. (Amplified Bible; Richest measure of His Divine Presence.)

Colossians 1:27 "To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."

It is Christ in us and manifest through us that is producing this great glory.

2 Corinthians 3:18 "But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord."

So the question is; What does this look like in a practical way? For the believer this is the fulfillment of all God has promised. For God it the fulfillment of everything He intended man to be when He created us. Everything He put in Adam will be restored to us and everything He put in Jesus Christ will become manifest in us. As we are filled with En-Thous all that God is begins to bring forth gifts, faith, power, authority and ministry.

Let us take a look at each one of these and others one at a time.

First we will look at gifts. Adam was greatly gifted because he was made in the image of God. He possessed great wisdom, knowledge and understanding. He was God's controller of the everything on the earth. As God fills the body of Christ today we too will have the wisdom,

knowledge, and understanding needed to function in God's behalf on the earth. This becomes possible because it isn't us doing it but God living in us and living His life through us. All He is becomes manifest in us as it was in Adam and in Jesus Christ. Jesus said: John 14:9 "Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

Next we will look at faith. Most people try to believe for too much and then become disappointed when it doesn't work. Stay simple and you will receive the faith of God which is absolute assurance. Start simple and then remain simple.

Hebrews 11:6 "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him."

God told Moses, I Am that I am. I Am, You Are, and He is, are all the same statement the only difference is in who is speaking. God says, I Am, we say to Him, You Are, and we tell each other, He Is. That is all we need to receive all that God has. When Jesus asked Peter; Who do you say that I am. Peter answered:

Matthew 16:16 "Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus informed Peter that this revelation didn't come from flesh and blood but from the Father.

Jesus said this confession of faith was enough to build the church.

Praying in the the Holy Spirit increases this absolute assurance because it is En-Thous flowing through us and praying the perfect will of God.

Jude 1:20 "But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most Holy Faith, praying in the Holy Spirit."

Jesus Christ has perfect faith and He lives in us. En-Thous.

Galatians 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith of the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

En-Thous power enables us to do everything God does and nothing is impossible.

Acts 1:8 "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Adam had authority over everything on the earth and Jesus said: "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth." Matthew 28:18

God dwells in us with all authority and everything is subjected to Him.

To accomplish His work on the earth Jesus placed Himself in men and then gave those men as gifts to the church. Ephesians 4:8 "Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, And gave gifts to men." The Greek word here indicates that Jesus gave Himself, so it is Jesus the Apostle in a man that makes a man an Apostle. It is Jesus the Prophet in a man that makes a man Prophet. It is Jesus Who came to seek and to save that which was lost in a man that, makes a man an Evangelist. It is Jesus the Good Shepherd in a man that makes a man a Pastor. It is Jesus the Teacher in a man that makes a man a Teacher.

There can only be Enthusiasm on the earth and in the Church of the Living God by receiving God Himself, and let Him live His life in and through us. En-Thous, God Within.

Ephesians 1:23. (The Church) Which is His body, the fullness of Him Who fills all in all [for in that body lives the full measure of Him Who makes everything complete, and Who fills everything everywhere with Himself]. Be God Possessed. Be Enthusiastic. Be Blessed.
