

## FAITH OF GOD

**2 Corinthians 4:13** Yet we have the same spirit (Holy Spirit, KJV) of faith as he had who wrote, I have believed, and therefore have I spoken. We too believe, and therefore we speak.

**1 Corinthians 12:9** to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit,

**Romans 10:17** So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

**Romans 12:3** For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think *of himself* more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.

**Hebrews 12:2** Looking away [from all that will distract] to Jesus, Who is the Leader and the Source of our faith [giving the first incentive for our belief] and is also its Finisher [bringing it to maturity and perfection]. He, for the joy [of obtaining the prize] that was set before Him, endured the cross, despising and ignoring the shame, and is now seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

**Hebrews 11:3** By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.

**2 Peter 1:1** Simon Peter, a servant and apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who through the righteousness of our God and Saviour Jesus Christ have received a faith as precious as ours:

**Mark 11:22-24** So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. (Have God Faith) For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive *them*, and you will have *them*."

**Jude 1:20** But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit,

**Romans 8:26** Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

**Hebrews 7:25** Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

**Hebrews 3:1** Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus,

**John 17:9** "I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours."

**John 17:15-18** I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.

In the AV "the faith of" is sometimes ambiguous; with reference to Christ it is objective, i.e., faith in Him, not His own faith, in the following passages in which the RV, "in" gives the correct meaning; Rom. 3:22; Gal. 2:16 (twice),20, RV, "I live in faith, the faith which is in the Son of God;" Gal. 3:22; Eph. 3:12; Phil. 3:9

Ambiguous (of language) open to more than one interpretation; having a double meaning : unclear or inexact because a choice between alternatives has not been made :

**Galatians 2:20 (KJV)** I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

**Galatians 2:16 (KJV)** Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

**Mark 11:22 (KJV)** And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

**Ephesians 2:8 (KJV)** For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God:

**Colossians 2:12 (KJV)** Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with *him* through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

**Acts 3:6 (KJV)** Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

**Acts 3:16 (KJV)** And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.

## **Scotfield References**

### **faith:**

The essence of faith consists in receiving what God has revealed, and may be defined as that trust in the God of the Scriptures and in Jesus Christ whom He hath sent, which receives Him as Saviour and Lord, and impels to loving obedience and good works [John 1:12](#); [James 2:14-26](#). The particular uses of faith give rise to its secondary definitions:

(1) For salvation, faith is personal trust, apart from meritorious works, in the Lord Jesus Christ, as delivered for our offences, and raised again for our justification [Romans 4:5,23-25](#).

(2) As used in prayer, faith is the "confidence that we have in him, that if we ask anything according to his will, he heareth us" [1 John 5:14,15](#).

(3) As used in reference to unseen things of which Scripture speaks, faith "gives substance" to them, so that we act upon the conviction of their reality. [Hebrews 11:1-3](#).

(4) As a working principle in life, the uses of faith are illustrated in [Hebrews 11:1-39](#).

**John 1:12** But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, {even} to those who believe in His name,

**James 2:14** What does it profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him?

**Romans 4:5** But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness,

### **1John 5:14-15**

This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us {in} whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.

**Hebrews 11:1-3** Now faith is the assurance of {things} hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. For by it the men of old gained approval. By faith we understand that the worlds were prepared by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things which are visible.

Galatians 2:15, 16 dby We, Jews by nature, and not sinners of *the* nations, but knowing that a man is not justified on the principle of works of law *nor* but by the faith of Jesus Christ, \*we\* also have believed on Christ Jesus, that we might be justified on the principle of *the* faith of Christ; and not of works of law; because on the principle of works of law no flesh shall be justified.”

Galatians 2:15, 16 drv

“We by nature are Jews: and not of the Gentiles, sinners.

But knowing that man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, we also believe in Christ Jesus, that we may be justified by the faith of Christ and not by the works of the law: because by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified.”
