HIS MANIFEST PRESENCE

W. E. Vine. Glory: It is used of the nature and acts of God in self-manifestation, i.e., what He essentially is and does, as exhibited in whatever way he reveals Himself in these respects.

Eph. 1:17, "the Father of glory" describes Him as the source from whom all Divine splendor and perfection proceed in their manifestation, and to whom they belong.

Ex 16:10 Now it came to pass, as Aaron spoke to the whole congregation of the children of Israel, that they looked toward the wilderness, and behold, the glory of the LORD appeared in the cloud.

Ex 24:16 Now the glory of the LORD rested on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days. And on the seventh day He called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud.

Ex 24:17 The sight of the glory of the LORD was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel.

Exodus 33:22 "So it shall be, while My glory passes by, that I will put you in the cleft of the rock, and will cover you with My hand while I pass by."

Ex 40:34 Then the cloud covered the tabernacle of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

Le 9:6 Then Moses said, "This is the thing which the LORD commanded you to do, and the glory of the LORD will appear to you."

Nu 16:42 Now it happened, when the congregation had gathered against Moses and Aaron, that they turned toward the tabernacle of meeting; and suddenly the cloud covered it, and the glory of the LORD appeared.

De 5:24 "And you said: 'Surely the LORD our God has shown us His glory and His greatness, and we have heard His voice from the midst of the fire. We have seen this day that God speaks with man; yet he still lives.'

2Ch 7:1-3 When Solomon had finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the glory of the LORD filled the temple. And the priests could not enter the house of the LORD, because the glory of the LORD had filled the LORD'S house. When all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the LORD on the temple, they bowed their faces to the ground on the pavement, and worshiped and praised the LORD, saying: "For He is good, For His mercy endures forever."

1 Kings 8:11 "so that the priests could not continue ministering because of the cloud; for the glory of the LORD filled the house of the LORD."

Ps 102:15-16 So the nations shall fear the name of the LORD, And all the kings of the earth Your glory. For the LORD shall build up Zion; He shall appear in His glory.

Isa 2:10 Enter into the rock, and hide in the dust, From the terror of the LORD And the glory of His majesty.

Isa 2:19 They shall go into the holes of the rocks, And into the caves of the earth, From the terror of the LORD And the glory of His majesty, When He arises to shake the earth mightily.

Ro 8:18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

Ro 11:36 For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen.

Ps 57:5 Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; Let Your glory be above all the earth.

Ps 63:2 So I have looked for You in the sanctuary, To see Your power and Your glory.

Ps 96:3 Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples.

Ps 105:3 Glory in His holy name; Let the hearts of those rejoice who seek the LORD!
