

2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

2 Corinthians 4:3-7 But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. For we do not preach ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord, and ourselves your bondservants for Jesus' sake. For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us."

1Co 15:49 And as we have borne the image of the *man* of dust, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly *Man*.

Joh 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

2Co 5:17 Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Ro 8:29 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to be* conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Ephesians 4:22-24 that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness."

Col 3:10 and have put on the new *man* who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him,

All of your love Jesus on display. Grace, Compassion, Joy, Power, Light. Glory, Wisdom, Knowledge.

Display His Love

Joh 13:35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.

Display His Joy

Joh 15:11 These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and *that* your joy may be full.

Joh 17:13 But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves.

Ac 2:28 You have made known to me the ways of life; You will make me full of joy in Your presence.'

Ro 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

Ac 13:52 And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

Ro 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing,

that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Jas 1:2 My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,

1 Peter 1:6-9 In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, that the genuineness of your faith, *being* much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ, whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see *Him*, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, receiving the end of your faith--the salvation of *your* souls."

1 Peter 4:12-13 Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy."

Display His Greatness:

1Jo 4:4* You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

Display His Holiness:

1 Peter 1:15, 16 but as He who called you *is* holy, you also be holy in all *your* conduct, because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

Re 22:11 "He who is unjust, let him be unjust still; he who is filthy, let him be filthy still; he who is righteous, let him be righteous still; he who is holy, let him be holy still."

Display Your Light:

2Co 4:6 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Display Your Peace:

Lu 8:48 And He said to her, "Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in peace."

Lu 10:6 "And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you.

Joh 14:27 "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Joh 16:33 "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

Joh 20:21 So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."

Ro 8:6 For to be carnally minded *is* death, but to be spiritually minded *is* life and peace.

Ro 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

Ro 15:33 Now the God of peace *be* with you all. Amen.
