MANIFEST GLORY

<u>1 Corinthians 12:7</u> "But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all:"

<u>John 14:21</u> "He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

Love creates and atmosphere where the Power and Glory of God can be manifest. Jesus first miracle took place at a wedding.

<u>John 2:11</u> "This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory; and His disciples believed in Him."

<u>James 4:8</u> "Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded."

<u>Psalms 139:14</u> "I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, And that my soul knows very well."

Jesus came to make God approachable and yet God didn't change.

Hebrews 10:19, 22 "Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holy place by the blood of Jesus, by the way which he dedicated for us, a new and living way, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; and having a High Priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water."
