WISDOM, KNOWLEDGE, UNDERSTANDING

WISDOM.

<u>Pr 2:6</u> For the LORD gives wisdom; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding;

<u>Pr 3:13</u>* Happy is the man who finds wisdom, And the man who gains understanding;

<u>Pr 4:7</u> Wisdom is the principal thing; Therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding.

<u>Pr 9:10</u> "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

<u>Pr 16:16</u> How much better to get wisdom than gold! And to get understanding is to be chosen rather than silver.

<u>Pr 3:19</u> The LORD by wisdom founded the earth; By understanding He established the heavens;

<u>Jer 51:15</u> He has made the earth by His power; He has established the world by His wisdom, And stretched out the heaven by His understanding.

Proverbs 8:27-30 (Amplified Bible)

When He prepared the heavens, I [Wisdom] was there; when He drew a circle upon the face of the deep and stretched out the firmament over it, When He made firm the skies above, when He established the fountains of the deep, When He gave to the sea its limit and His decree that the waters should not transgress [across the boundaries set by] His command, when He appointed the foundations of the earth. Then I [Wisdom] was beside Him as a master and director of the work; and I was daily His delight, rejoicing before Him always. Proverbs 8:10-11 (Amplified Bible)

Receive my instruction in preference to [striving for] silver, and knowledge rather than choice gold, For skillful and godly Wisdom is better than rubies or pearls, and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it.

Wisdom has to do with design.

Engineering what needs to be brought into existence according to purpose and need.

Gift of the Spirit.

James 1:5 If any of you is deficient in wisdom, let him ask of the giving God [Who gives] to everyone liberally and ungrudgingly, without reproaching or faultfinding, and it will be given him.

James 3:17 But the wisdom from above is first of all pure (undefiled); then it is peace-loving, courteous (considerate, gentle). [It is willing to] yield to

reason, full of compassion and good fruits; it is wholehearted and straightforward, impartial and unfeigned (free from doubts, wavering, and insincerity).

1Cor 12:4 Now there are distinctive varieties and distributions of endowments (gifts, extraordinary powers distinguishing certain Christians, due to the power of divine grace operating in their souls by the Holy Spirit) and they vary, but the [Holy] Spirit remains the same.

1Cor 12:5 And there are distinctive varieties of service and ministration, but it is the same Lord [Who is served].

1Cor 12:6 And there are distinctive varieties of operation [of working to accomplish things], but it is the same God Who inspires and energizes them all in all

1Cor 12:7 But to each one is given the manifestation of the [Holy] Spirit [the evidence, the spiritual illumination of the Spirit] for good and profit.

1Cor 12:8 To one is given in and through the [Holy] Spirit [the power to speak] a message of wisdom, and to another [the power to express] a word of knowledge and understanding according to the same [Holy] Spirit;

Psa 50:23* Whoever offers praise glorifies Me; And to him who orders his conduct aright I will show the salvation of God."

1John 5:20. And we [have seen and] know [positively] that the Son of God has [actually] come to this world and has given us understanding and insight [progressively] to perceive (recognize) and come to know better and more clearly Him Who is true; and we are in Him Who is true--in His Son Jesus Christ (the Messiah). This [Man] is the true God and Life eternal.

1Jo 2:21 I have not written to you because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and that no lie is of the truth.

<u>1Ti 3:15</u> but if I am delayed, I write so that you may know how you ought to conduct yourself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.
