Psalms 30:12 "To the end that my glory may sing praise to You and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks to You forever."

Acts 18:9 "Now the Lord spoke to Paul in the night by a vision, "Do not be afraid, but speak, and do not keep silent;"

2 Corinthians 4:13 "And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak,"

Colossians 4:3 "meanwhile praying also for us, that God would open to us a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in chains,"

2 Timothy 1:13 "Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus."

Romans 15:13 "Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit."

WORDS OF PEACE

Luke 10:5 ""But whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house.'"

2 Peter 1:2 "Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord,"

WORDS OF POWER

Hebrews 4:12 "For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."

WORDS OF TESTIMONY

Revelation 12:11 ""And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death."

WORDS OF TRUTH

Ephesians 4:25 "Therefore, putting away lying, "Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor," for we are members of one another."

WORDS OF LIFE

Acts 5:20 ““Go, stand in the temple and speak to the people all the words of this life.””

John 6:63 ““It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.”

John 6:68 “But Simon Peter answered Him, “Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.”

WORDS OF EDIFICATION

1Co 14:4 He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church.

Romans 14:19 “Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another.”

1 Thessalonians 5:11 “Therefore comfort each other and edify one another, just as you also are doing.”

Ephesians 4:29 “Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.”

WORDS OF HEALING

Matthew 8:8 “The centurion answered and said, “Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed.”

WORDS OF PRAYER AND THANKSGIVING

Colossians 4:2 “Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving;”

WORDS OF SONG

Ephesians 5:19 “speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,”

Colossians 3:16 “Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.”

WORDS OF WISDOM

1 Corinthians 2:6, 7 “However, we speak wisdom among those who are mature, yet not the wisdom of this age, nor of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing. But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden wisdom which God ordained before the ages for our glory,”

WORDS OF CONFESSION

Romans 10:9, 10 “That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”

Hebrews 10:23 “Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.”

WORDS OF PRAISE

1 Peter 2:9 “But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;”
